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TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1 – Port Elizabeth, Addo Elephant National Park, Plettenberg Bay

Exploring Addo Elephant National Park in our tour vehicle. We will spend up to 2-3 hours exploring the 48,000-hectare National reserve with approximately 700 elephant and some Cape buffalo, lion, black rhino, warthog, zebra, eland, kudu, hartebeest and many more animals.

We head towards Storms River Mouth having lunch along the way. We take a walk to the mouth of the river over suspension bridges that span these amber-coloured waters. Here, dramatic cliff faces meet the power of the swell coming in from the Southern Ocean as they burst in great sprays of white foam in protest at the interruption of their unconfined freedom.

We continue through the heart of the Garden Route. Here hazy mountains lie carpeted in lush forests bordered by colourful fynbos, the diverse indigenous flora of the region. We approach our overnight accommodation in Plettenberg Bay with its spectacular views over Baia Formosa or “Beautiful Bay” it was called by the early Portuguese explorers.

Day 2 – Plettenberg Bay, Knysna, George, Oudtshoorn

Early morning wakeup we depart along the Garden Route driving towards Knysna stopping along the way and take in all the beautiful scenery. Having breakfast en-route towards Knysna, stopping at the Heads Lookout point. Arriving in Oudtshoorn we participate in their Orphan Elephant experience that is a must to do. The afternoon in Oudtshoorn we visit the Cango Caves on a guided tour. After the Cango Caves we head towards our overnight accommodation and get booked in and freshen up for the evening dinner.

Day 3 – Oudtshoorn, Cape Agulhas, Hermanus

After a delicious breakfast, we check out and start the day with a guided tour at the Ostrich Farm. Afterwards we depart for Cape Agulhas. En-route we stop and enjoy a delicious lunch. We continue on the Garden Route, through stunning scenery to the picturesque town of Swellendam, turn south towards Cape Agulhas. Cape Agulhas is the most Southern Tip of Africa we stop and take photos at this landmark. We head towards Hermanus for our overnight stop.

Here we can view the Southern Right Whales from June to Nov as they come close to our shores.

Day 4 – Hermanus, Bettys Bay, Cape Point, Cape Town

After a delicious breakfast, we check out and depart for Cape Point, but first we stop at Betty's Bay and view the Cape Jackass Penguins up close. Arriving at Cape Point we take a walk around Cape Point with its spectacular views. Cape Town from the interior as we approach our mother city, Cape Town, nestled in the warm embrace of Table Mountain.

Here we check into our accommodation and freshen up before heading into Cape Town to sample the fare at one of the many world class restaurants that can be found in this cosmopolitan City. We explore the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront or you party the night away at some of the venues of the vibrant nightlife which the City is so well known for.
